Cleanbill recently listed every single General Practitioner (GP) clinic in Greater Perth.

All 463 of them.

This report outlines the aggregate bulk billing and out-ofpocket cost data we gathered from listing these clinics.



Out-of-Pocket Costs

Below are the five suburbs with the highest average out-of-pocket costs and lowest average out-of-pocket costs for a standard consultation, split by the average out-of-pocket cost for a standard consultation in Greater Perth.



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Historic Comparison

Cleanbill also has access to historic data from 2018 for GP clinics in select suburbs⁶ around Greater Perth. These suburbs were selected to provide an accurate picture of the broader socio-economic mix of the Greater Perth area. The below table compares the results from a July 2018 survey with the results from the same suburbs in Cleanbill's current listing cycle.

Conclusion

Cleanbill's recent listing of every GP clinic in Greater Perth represents a comprehensive survey of the current state of primary care accessibility in Australia's 4th largest city.

Fewer than 1 in 3 Perth GP clinics offer bulk billing for all adults. At the 70.8% of GP clinics that do not offer bulk billing for adults, a person can expect to pay an average of \$79.25 for a standard, 15-minute consultation. Just over half of this amount (\$39.75) is covered by Medicare.

Across a narrower sample, these figures have not changed significantly since 2018. The change in bulk billing rates is within the margin of error⁷ and the change in out-of-pocket costs has tracked below inflation over the same period of time.

⁷ The margin of error accounts for all the possible bulk billing rates if quotes could have been obtained from the same number of clinics across the two time periods.
